To foster awareness and action towards biodiversity conservation and local environmental issues, cultivating a culture of cleanliness and environmental responsibility among students through various activities and initiatives.


Objectives:

2. Promoting use of EV- Walkathon





We left college premises by 8 a.m by 9.50 a.m and we reached the destination.


We were received by Dr.Ashwini K.M microbiologist, the resource person for the workshop.


Introduction about multicrop farming and the entire idea of organic farms was discussed students students were taken to te cafeteria for breakfast.

- 1. Water harvesting natural mode of water course created for the supply of the water through out the farm was explained, natural rain water course created, distribution of water and utilization of water by the plants and trees concepts was discussed.
- 2. Areca nut farms, cocoa farms. Jack fruit farms(different variety) plus medicinal plants , vegetables farming was explained and there was hands on experience.
- 3. The manure and organic compost making was explained.
- 4. The usage of coconut coir for the purpose of water observation at the grass roots and its importance was explained
- 5. Bee hive farming yield was explained.
- There was opportunity to explore tree houses.
