Committee Reports

2018 - 19



Aims and objectives:

The Student Executive Council serves as a representative body of the college's student community. By organizing various events throughout the year, the Council enables the students to enhance their personal growth and develop leadership skills. The Council comprises of various committees aligning with the interests of the students. It has consistently supported the student community in attaining academic and professional excellence.

Major activities conducted/events held:

- 1. The Student Executive Council inauguration along with the Teachers' Day celebration and Freshers' Day on 05-08-2018
- The Silver Jubilee Endowment Lecture for the year was delivered by Hon'ble Sri. Tushar Mehta, the Solicitor General of India on 17-11-2018



Aims and objectives:

The primary aim of Internal Quality Assurance Cell is to develop a system of conscious, consistent and catalytic actions to improve the academic and administrative performance of the institution and to promote measures for institutional functioning towards quality enhancement through internalization of quality culture and institutionalization of the best practices.

The IQAC is a by-product of the ongoing efforts to define the objectives of the institution. It focuses on having a work plan to achieve these objectives and to specify the checks and balances to evaluate the degree to which each of the tasks are fulfilled. Thus, devotion and commitment to improvement rather than mere institutional control is the basis for devising procedures and instruments for assuring quality in the institute.

Major activities conducted/events held:

- 1. Orientation for freshers: This was organized under the banner of IQAC, with Dr. Tharanath, Principal of our institute, giving an overview of our college. All the faculty members introduced themselves and gave a brief overview of the various cells/committees operational in the institute. The programme witnessed the participation of around 200 parents who attended a PTA meeting on the same day. The second session for the day was held in the afternoon from 12.00 pm to 2.00 pm. A session on "Soft skill and Grooming" was taken up by Ms. C.A. Rachelee Adeline D'sa, Trisha Classes, Mangaluru.
- 2. Faculty recharge programme: On 16th August, 2018, the faculty recharge programme was organizedin collaboration with Dr. Vishal Samartha, Professor and Director, Department of Business Administration, Sahyadri College of Engineering and Management, Mangaluru, Mrs. Vinatha K, Associate Professor, Department of Psychology, St Agnes College (Autonomous), Mangaluruand, Dr. Kavyashree K B, Assistant Professor, Department of PG Studies in Clinical Psychology, St Agnes College (Autonomous), Mangaluru who were the resource persons for the programme.
- 3. IQAC meetings: The IQAC meetings are being conducted regularly as per NAAC guidelines in furtherance of which one IQAC meeting is being held every quarter of the academic year. For the academic year 2018-19, till date, two meetings have been successfully conducted.


